

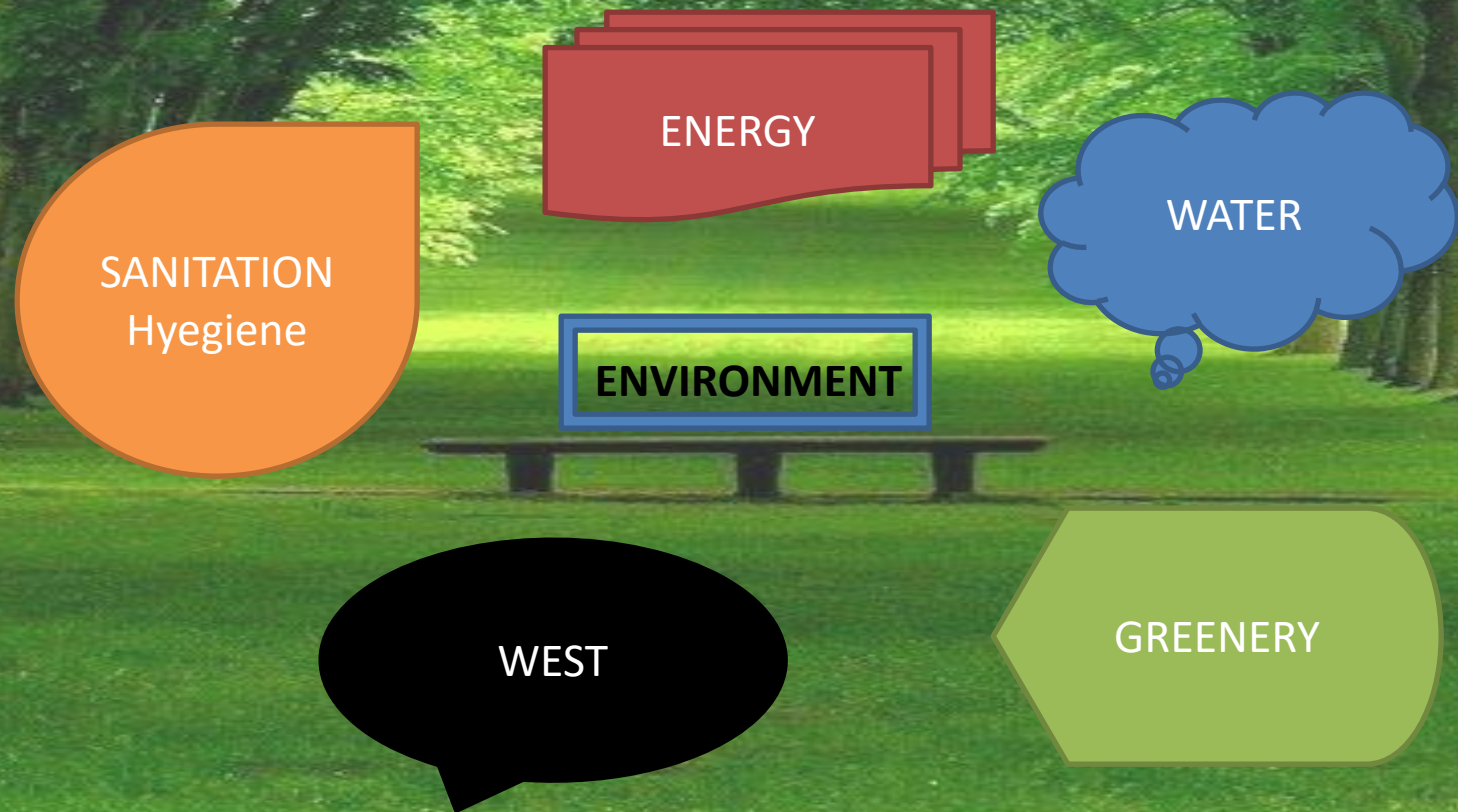

Objectives of Module One:

1. The Module teaches about tobacco ill effects on humans .
2. Air being an important aspect of environment, its quality needs to be understood and thereby prevention of its pollution is of utmost importance
3. The safety of BMW workers is of utmost importance. The precautionary measures and their safety acts as a value added course for their safety.
4. The PPE kit for BMW workers should be provided and they need training in regards to injuries while handling BMW.

Specified outcome

- Participants should have brief idea of tobacco hazards.
- The contribution an individual can enhance in controlling air pollution and encourage others in doing so.
- Creating awareness among BMW workers about PPE and accidental injuries and exposures.

❖ Objectives of Module Two:

1. Module 2 explains importance of cleanliness. Hand washing is an integral part of daily routine. The steps have to be thoroughly followed for clean hands.
2. The public is aware of water scarcity and here comes rain water harvesting to create awareness regarding its importance.
3. The BMW has to be handled carefully and disposed off.
4. Littering in the surrounding is hazards to public and environment and thus here are explain color coded bags and disposal

Specified outcome

- At the end of session, participants should have the knowledge of through hand washing, importance of rain and harvesting and Management of BMW and its disposal.

- **Objectives of Module Three:**

1. Module 3 explains briefly about minor accidents and PPE importance for BMW works. The health of BMW workers should be treated as equally important and be provided with all safety awareness
2. The general waste is as equivalent as BMW and has to be disposed off equal importance.
3. Importance of tree plantation is well known to all and should be an on-going process.

- General waste has to treated appropriately to maintain cleanliness.
- All individuals will support and maintain the surroundings with tree plantation.

- **Objectives of Module Three:**

1. Module 4 explains about human impact on environment and how hazardous it can be .
2. The BMW workers has to be taught about importance of training and awareness of waste handling , do's and don'ts and their health checkups annually.
3. While considering air pollution ,waste management ,noise pollution needs to keep a check up and management.
